## Sheets Numbering System

### Standard colors:

Both the back of the sheet and the long side of the sheet have print codes. At the back of sheet, the last two numbers mean batch number. For example the number on the **back** of the sheet below:

230144 01132016 01 means

- ◆ 2 (1/2" thickness)
- ◆ 30 (width)
- ◆ 144 (length)
- ◆ 01 (month)
- ◆ 13 (day)
- ◆ 2020 (year)
- ◆ 01 (batch number)

At the long edge of the sheet, the number sequence will be similar, however, the last two numbers represent the sequence of sheets from one batch

For example the number on the **edge** of the sheet below:

230144 01132020 01 40 means

- ◆ 2 (1/2" thickness)
- ◆ 30 (width)
- ◆ 144 (length)
- ◆ 01 (month)
- ◆ 13 (day)
- ◆ 2020 (year)
- ◆ 01 (batch number)
- ◆ 40 (sequence or sheet number)

### Vein colors:

Only the long side of the sheet has printing

For example the number on the **edge** of the sheet below:

230144 01132020 01 40 PASSED → means

- ◆ 2 (1/2" thickness)
- ◆ 30 (width)
- ◆ 144 (length)
- ◆ 01 (month)
- ◆ 13 (day)
- ◆ 2020 (year)
- ◆ 01 (batch number)
- ◆ 40 (sequence or sheet number)

Note: The arrow following the numbers ( " → ") means pattern direction.

Therefore, sheet numbers are indicated by the last two numbers printed on the side **edge** of the sheet.
